Here is an adjusted recipe for a smaller group:

2 - 15 oz cans mild chili beans

1 - 15 oz can regular pinto beans

1 small cube chicken bouillon

2 Tablespoons fresh mild salsa (not canned)

Mix together and cook until heated through. Serve over rice.
