SEEKING GOD BY FASTING AND PRAYING

Principle

1. <u>Fasting</u> – Matthew 6:17-18, "But when you fast, comb your hair and wash your face. Then no one will notice that you are fasting, except your Father, who knows what you do in private. And your Father, who sees everything, will reward you."

Fasting reminds us of how much we need food; let it also remind you of how much you need God and his provision

2. <u>Praying</u> – Psalm 5:3, "Listen to my voice in the morning, LORD. Each morning I bring my requests to you and wait expectantly."

Prayer is how God's people get things done; it is personal conversation with a personal God; it is the greatest expression of faith; it is asking boldly and submitting confidently to the Lord's perfect will

Practice

- 1. As we begin 2022, seek to incorporate fasting into your life over the <u>next two weeks</u>, whether daily or however God leads you.
- 2. Consider partnering with someone—a spouse, a child, a friend.
- 3. Intentionally pray during those times of hunger (and other times) for the following:
 - <u>Days 1-5:</u> Church Health—Unity, peace, holiness, trust over fear, hearts to serve and give, gospel depth and centrality, healing in relationships (Eph 4:1-5; 11-16)
 - <u>Days 6-9: Community Welfare</u>—Civic institutions, health care workers, regional churches and pastors, non-Christian neighbors, gospel advance in Madison through word and deed (Jer 29:7; 1 Tim 2:1-4)
 - <u>Days 10-14: Ministry Effectiveness</u>—prayer; preaching; Sunday worship; pastors and elders; deacons; missions; teaching; life groups; children and Awana; MS and HS youth; quilting; future church building
